Dear Parents/Carers,

Welcome to Class One! We are really looking forward to a fun, busy term.

Please find attached our class Topic Web – this gives you an overview of what we aim to cover this Autumn Term.

Things to remember:

- Book bags need to be in school daily. Your child will read regularly to an adult in school. Please listen to your child read on a regular basis and update your child's reading record. You can write in the record when you read a book from home too.
- Book bags need to be placed in a book bag box – there are 3, red, green and blue. Each box has a list of names on the front.
- PE kits need to be put in your child's locker on a Monday and taken home on a Friday.
- Your child can bring in a named water bottle into school. There is always water available throughout the day.
- A snack is provided for your child, however if you wish, your child can bring in a **healthy snack** to eat at break time. This needs to be labelled and put in the green snack basket.
- Please provide a coat for the cooler weather. This can be kept in your child's locker.
- We have a wellie rack outside for your child to keep a pair of named wellies in school. Wellies can also be kept in your child's locker.
- Please make sure all clothing is clearly labelled with your child's name, including shoes/pumps.
- Please could we ask for children to refrain from bringing in their own toys into school. Children get very upset if their toys get broken by accident or go missing!
- As well as been given a school reading scheme book, children are allowed to choose a book from our class collection to take home. Children are encouraged to do this independently.
