Teachers are happy to speak to parents at the end of the day to answer any questions and will approach parents if they have concerns about a particular child. We have a very 'open door' policy and teachers can also be contacted by email via the school admin email address. In Class 1, Tapestry is used extensively, in partnership with parents, to share children's outcomes. From September 2017, parents will be invited into school on a regular basis to view their child's work. Specific details will be provided when we return to school in September and it is likely to be on a set day each month.
