Dear Parents/Carers,

Things to remember:

- Book bags need to be in school daily. Your child will read regularly to an adult in school. Please listen to your child read on a regular basis and update your child's reading record.
- PE kits need to be put in your child's locker on a Monday and taken home on a Friday.
- Your child can bring in a named water bottle into school. There is always water available throughout the day.
- Your child can bring in a healthy snack to eat at break time.
- Please provide a coat for the cooler weather. This can be kept in your child's locker.
- We have a wellie rack outside for your child to keep a pair of named wellies in school.
- Please make sure all clothing is clearly labelled with your child's name, including shoes/pumps.
- There is a **green basket** as you enter the room, just past the lockers. This basket is there for you/your child to put home link book messages, money, messages into. The basket will be checked at the start of the day by an adult.
- Any monies for school dinners etc are to be put in a named, sealed envelope stating what the money is for.
- Please could we ask for children to refrain from bringing in their own toys into school. Children get very upset if their toys get broken by accident or go missing!
