We will also continue revising instant recall of times tables.

Science

This term in Science, we will be exploring properties and changes of materials.

Geography

We will be studying how rivers are formed, revising the water cycle, and recognising different stages of a river's journey from source to sea. We will then move on to studying how mountains are formed, looking at different mountain ranges around the world and how mountain environments are changed by climate change and human activity.
