English

This half term we will be reading *The Sea Book* by Charlotte Milner, a non-fiction book all about our oceans. We will be basing our writing on the book *Seal Surfer* by Michael Foreman.

Science

In science we will be learning about Animals including humans. We will find out about life cycles, survival and how to stay healthy.

History

In history this half-term we will be learning about the Ancient Greeks. We will be investigating where and when they lived, what they believed in and what life was like in Ancient Greece.
