English

Oak will be studying the book 'Star of Fear, Star of Hope'. The writing outcome is to write a story including a flashback from another character's point of view. The reading lessons will be based around the book 'When we were Warriors' by Emma Carroll Genre.

Science

Our science topic for this half term is Earth and Space. We will study our solar system, learn about the relative movements of the planets and the Moon and relating these to the way we experience the Sun and the Moon on Earth.

History

Oak will learn about the Industrial Revolution, the impact it had on our local area and explore what life was like for people in Shropshire during that time, we will study significant individuals such as Abraham Darby and Thomas Telford.

Computing

We will begin the term learning about the importance of using the internet safely and explore how to do that. Our other topic will be programming- selection in quizzes. This unit uses the Scratch programming platform to support pupils' learning in computing.

Maths

Our maths units are place value, addition and subtraction, multiplication and division and fractions.

Religious Education

Through our religious studies we will study the question 'What does it mean if God is Holy and Loving?'

Art

Children will be introduced to typography design and they explore how to create their own fonts and designs. We will explore how to use visual letters and other elements to help convey ideas and emotions.
