English

Oak will be studying 'Queen of the Falls' for writing and poetry, characters and an alternative ending. The writing outcome is to write a series of diaries about significant events in Annie Edson Taylor's life. We will also study 'The Lost Happy Endings' with the writing outcome to write a traditional story focussing on describing setting,

Maths

Our maths units are calculating using knowledge of structures, multiples of 1,000, numbers up to 10,000,000 and multiplication and division.

Reading
