English

Oak will be studying the following books: 'The Selfish Giant' with the writing outcome to write a narrative explanation text and 'The Day the War Came' writing outcome is to write a persuasive letter.

The whole class reading sessions will be based around the books 'The Happy Prince and Other Tale' and 'The Goldfish Boy'.

Science

Our science topic for this half term is Properties and changes of materials.

Geography

Oak will be learning about North America. We will explore the physical and human geography of North America, with a regional focus on Mexico City.

Computing
