Rules: 1. Words ending in -cian are occupations. 2 If a root word ends in -c or -cs, then it is spelt -cian e.g. music – musician.	Rules: 1. The -able endings are far more common than the -ible endings. 2ible is the most common ending when a full root word can't be heard e.g. possible (poss). There are some exceptions (sense → sensible).

Top Tips for learning a spelling:

- Test yourself how many do you know? Look at what you got right and what you got wrong. Often, people are wrong only because of one letter.
- 2. Learn your spellings using scrabble tiles. Pick out the letters to make the word. Mix them up and make the word from memory.

- 3. Look at the way colour has been used in the examples. The colour is used to pick out the rule or the syllables: Write out your spellings using this two colour method: vegetable
- 4. Find words within words: vegetable
- 5. Learn the rule. Make sure you understand it.
- 6. Make your own flashcards learn three a day.
