English

Oak will be learning about writing myths using Arthur and the Golden Rope by Joe Todd Stanton. Our reading work will feature Odd and the Frost Giants by Neil Gaiman. We will be studying the poem, *'Guarding Secrets'* and writing poems inspired by it.

Science

Oak will be learning about animals including humans, which include circulation and healthy lifestyles.

History

Oak will be learning about why Ancient Greece is so important to our society today. Children will learn about the importance of trade and how Greek culture spread; city states and their locations; significant individuals, events and ideas; the importance of artefacts and what they tell us about daily life.

Music

Music this year will be taught by a visiting teacher from Shropshire Music Service. Year 5 and 6 will learn about beat and rhythm. Year 5 children will have separate whole class instrument lessons using the DooD.

Maths

This term children will be working on place multiplication, division, fractions, decimals, percentages and area using White Rose Maths.

Religious Education

Art

Oak will be exploring identity, creating layered portraits of each other using a range of media.
