English

Our English this half term will continue focusing on the text 'The Island' where we are learning about Charles Darwin's evolutionary discoveries. We will be writing an explanatory report about Darwin's discoveries.

We will also be completing daily reading lessons where we will be working on inference skills, defining vocabulary and making summaries of texts.

We will continue to cover different aspects of spelling, punctuation and grammar through our daily English lessons and through some discrete grammar lessons. Please ensure your child completes any spelling homework set over the next few weeks.

History

In History, we will be learning about the ancient Maya. We will be learning why the Maya is a significant ancient civilisation, exploring the characteristic features of a Maya city, comparing Maya culture with other ancient civilisations, and exploring artefacts.
