## English

Our English will be based around the text, 'The Lost Happy Endings' by Carol Ann Duffy. We will be learning how to integrate dialogue effectively, use parenthesis and develop our use of expanded noun phrases.

#### Science

In Science, our topic is Earth and Space. We will be finding out how to

Describe the movement of the Earth, and other planets, relative to the Sun in the solar system.

- · Describe the movement of the Moon relative to the Earth.
- $\cdot$  Describe the Sun, Earth and Moon as approximately spherical bodies.
- $\cdot$  Use the idea of the Earth's rotation to explain day and night and the apparent movement of the sun across the sky.

# Geography

In Geography, we will be refining our locational knowledge and investigating, 'Is all America the USA?' and then exploring the continent of South America in further detail.

# Computing

In Computing, we will be learning what makes a good web page and use this information to design and evaluate their own website using Google Sites.

### Maths

In maths, we will be comparing and ordering fractions, adding and subtracting fractions and mixed numbers, multiplying and dividing fractions by whole numbers, and converting metric and imperial measures.
