BICTON CHRISTMAS PARTY 2025 SUMMARY

We aim to answer some questions that you may have before the party, so you know what is happening. You can then discuss this with your grown up beforehand and we hope this helps you. We have tried to think about questions that you may have and given answers below.

What is happening at the party?

We are going to have a party in the school hall! There will be some games and food for the first 30 minutes. There will be chance to buy some extra treats (cake and popcorn) throughout the party. We will then have a disco for the rest of the party where music will be played, and people can dance if they want to. The main reason for the party is to have fun!

Your parent will need to pay for you to come to the party before the week of the party. These are bought from the school reception. Your name will be kept on a list so you don't need an actual ticket to come in.

Timings for the party:

3.15pm	School ends. Time to relax and get ready for the party
3.30pm	Teachers will support you to come to the party if you have paid. Party starts! You will have chance to eat and play some games at the beginning.
4pm	The disco will start. Music will be played.
4.30pm	Children may start to collect their bags ready to go home.
4.45pm	The party ends. You will be collected from the side door of the hall by your parent or carer. You can go home and relax!

Who will be there?

This party is for kids only. There will be a couple of teachers and a few other adults running stalls and games. All adults are very friendly, and most are parents of other children at the school.

What if I don't want to dance?

That is not a problem at all. There will be seating around the hall, and you can chat or play with friends. There will be some other activities such as colouring and items to buy also if you want to try those.

Will it be loud?

There will be other children playing and talking. We will play music quietly at first but will later turn this up for the disco part. We will not make this loud and will keep this at the same volume. There will **not** be any balloons so don't worry about any banging sounds when they pop.

What will I see?

The hall will be decorated for Christmas but will not look much different to usual. There may be more lights than usual and Christmas decorations in the hall.

There will be benches and tables around the side and there will be different items and games on each table.

The lights will be normal for the first part of the party and then we will dim some lights for the disco part of the event later. You will always be able to see clearly.

Do I have to join in the games?

The games at this party will cost 50p a go. There will be games like a tombola and other games to try. You get to keep any prizes that you might win but you will not win at every game. You don't have to try any games if you do not want to.

Can I eat?

There will be some basic party food available which will be jam or chocolate spread sandwiches, crisps, snackss and other vegetable snacks, which are free. Other treats such as cake and popcorn will cost 50p each (popcorn will be in bags). Drinks will also be available (squash and water).

How much money might I need?

This is completely up to you (and your adult who keeps the money!). Everything will be 50p each and this applies to each game or food item (e.g. 1 cake or one go at a game/). You might want to bring enough for a couple of things but you will not require a lot of extra money. Your ticket price includes the basic food and drink with it as well as the disco.

What if I feel worried during the disco?

You can always speak to an adult during the disco and discuss any worries that you might have. We will then do our best to help you.
